Cost effective Electric Cycle - a need oriented innovation by RPTC student

Jeva Joseph our 3rd year DME student, travel in his bicycle for 6 km to reach Rane Polytechnic from his village. His struggle to travel a long distance motivated him to put his technical skills into practice to convert his cycle into an electric one. With an investment of less than ₹10k, using a 3500 RPM Permanent Magnet DC motor and a 24 V lithium battery, he designed his own Electric cycle(EC)that runs at 25kmph speed and covers a distance of 30 km in a single charge.

RPTC continues to recognize the meritorious students by way of awarding Merit scholarships of Rs. 5,000/- student / department every year to motivate the students to continuously improve their academic performance.
